

Minutes of the Knox County Historical Society of Edina, Missouri

August 17, 2021

Door prizes and refreshments are needed, and all historical society members are encouraged to participate to help make this a successful fundraiser.

Kathryn Wilkerson has agreed to present a program on the history of the Knox County Historical Society at the September meeting. RaNae Vaughn will be contacted regarding the program at the October meeting.

The Knox County Christmas event is tentatively scheduled for Saturday, November 27, to coincide with Small Business Saturday. The historical society will make plans to participate in some way.
